You will be talking to guests and tourists, assisting them in their choice of bikes to rent for the day, and making sure the bike is fitted correctly for them.

You will be responsible for keeping a clean and professional work environment. You will be responsible for making bookings and advising customers on the right equipment. You should be able to provide advice on trails in the area, equipment maintenance, and safety.
